## COACHES/PLAYERS/OFFICIAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules the rules of Lorne Football / Netball Club and the laws of the game. Never argue with an umpire or other official without these people you can't play Football / Netball.
- All Coaches, players and officials associated with Netball as part of the LFNC will also adhere to all of Netball Australia's National Codes of Behaviour as which are adopted by the Victorian Netball Association registration regulations.
- Control your temper verbal abuse of officials sledging or bullying other players will not be tolerated.
- Be a team player It is a team game, respect and support one and other.
- Cooperate and support your coach, the umpires and team-mates. Play for your own enjoyment, improve your skills, aim to succeed.
- Do not in any way use negative remarks based on race, religion, gender, sexuality or ability you will let down your coach, team-mates and club. Such comments are illegal.

## PARENTS/SUPPORTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Remember that you are there for the participation and to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- All parents and supporters associated with Netball as part of the LFNC will also adhere to all of Netball Australia's National Codes of Behaviour as which are adopted by the Victorian Netball Association registration regulations.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognize all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time, they are not there to be abused.
- Never publicly criticize umpires raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use negative remarks based on race, religion, gender, sexuality or ability, such comments are illegal.
